## Libguides @ NorQuest

- Libguides CMS and LibCal 3/3/3 (free)
  - 52 guides
  - 150,000 guide views since July
  - Called Research Guides

## Why we added the Libguides LTI Tool

- To make our students aware of our guides and resources at the point of instruction
- To give Faculty a tool to add our content into their courses
  - In the case of content boxes and pages this is new functionality
- To increase the use of our services and resources
